Your firm's next Annual Update is due: October 31, 2026.

Your firm's 3-Year Review is due: October 31, 2028.

*****if you are ONLY certified as an Interstate DBE, you do not need to submit a 3-Year Review. Submit an Annual Update every year.***

To notify DSBO of any changes to your firm's legal structure, ownership, management, or control, within thirty (30) days of such change, submit a Material Change Application available on the [Small Business Certification and Contract Management System](#).
